My Bridal White is an exploration of the bridal ritual, centered on the multifaceted symbolism of the color white. In this work, the gown is not merely a garment but a charged symbol of transformation, where the individual is often subsumed by a collective ideal.

The piece examines the enduring cultural phenomenon of marriage as a universal feminine aspiration. It critiques the process by which a woman is rendered into a "purity void" — a blank, white canvas where her personal history and unique identity are bleached away to accommodate the expectations, roles, and "colors" projected onto her by society and others.

"Who am I when I wear the white bridal dress?"

It challenges the viewer to consider whether the bride is a participant in her own story or a silent vessel for a prescribed mode of womanhood.
